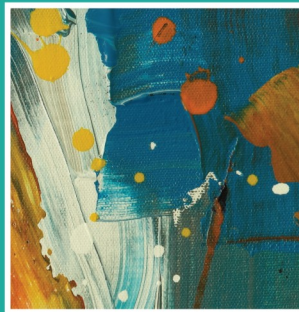
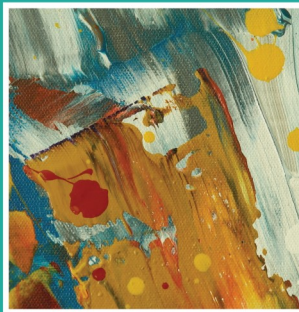
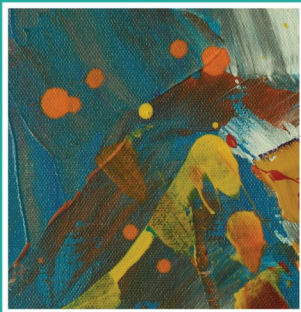
PRESIDENT'S CORNER

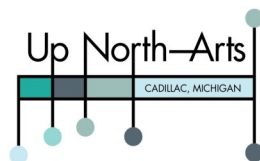
We need you! We'll provide the canvases, you provide the imagination.

- 3 Register for the 53rd Phyllis Olson Art Fair, and pay your jury fee (\$40 first medium, \$15 each additional medium)
- 4 Submit your registration and payment. Log out.
- 5 Email your 5-6 images to artfair@upnorthartsinc.com •

- Once jury selection is made, you will have an option to pay for your booth. Please do not send booth fee with jury fee.

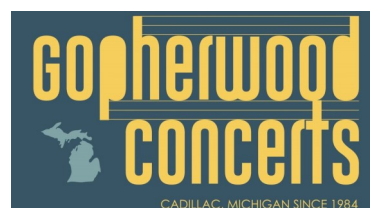
