



Up North Arts and Cadillac Art Council would like to announce the postponement of the Art Fair and Festival until 2022. After months of contingency planning for a COVID safe event, significantly low artist applications, low food vendor interest and limited volunteers - we have decided to postpone until 2022.

We are planning on having a number of activities for the community to participate in the week of July 11— *Tiny Canvas Scholarship Sale, Kids chalk art competition,*

Taste of Cadillac restaurant week, live music at the pavilion and a YArt Sale are a few things we are planning on now.

We truly rely on the community in terms of volunteer support, and we hope that continuing supporting the arts is important to everyone.

SCAM ALERT Also, we have been alerted by multiple people that there are people claiming to be representatives of our organization. They are offering booths for \$100, and that is not even how a juried fine art fair works. If you've been contacted by or sent money to one of these people, please be advised that it's a scam and contact us right away. Our festival is postponed and artists were notified in May.


