

Fused Glass Wind Chimes

Learn how to fuse glass while creating a fantastic multi part wind chime. Body of the wind chime is a 6" fused glass tile that you will create using a precut glass base and accessory glass including stringers (spaghetti-like glass strings), frit (crushed bits of glass) and other inclusions. "Chimes" are fused glass pieces that you will create interspaced with mirror tiles and beads for a wonderful sound and rainbow reflection. All materials and tools (including kiln firing) are supplied. \$40 materials fee payable to instructor first day of class.




