



No class on 5/28, (the 4th week) as students will have a break to allow for pieces they've made to be bisque fired. The 5th week student will return to decorate their pieces applying varied glazing techniques. The 6th week all will gather to show off their finished pieces and enjoying light refreshments. 1. What made you decide to join the UNA board?

Art has always been an integral part of my life. When asked to attend an UNA board meeting last May, I saw it as a way to become more involved with the community in a way I enjoy.

2. What life experiences have you had that inspired you to take a leadership role in the arts?

I was living and working in Washington DC in 2001. After 9/11, I was permanently laid off and moved back to Michigan. The Shiawassee Art Center hired me as their Gallery Manager. It was a wonderful experience learning how to operate an art center.

During this time, I was fortunate to be able to return to teaching at Lansing Community College. In 2004, I left the art center to become faculty advisor for the Japan Adventure Program in Otsu, Japan. In 2006, I returned to Japan for a second time.

I was the art instructor for the Disability Network in Lansing teaching adults from 18-80 from 2016 - 2020.

3. What is your favorite artistic medium?

I think of myself as a multi-media artist; a few of my favorite mediums include clay, stone, and wire.

4. Do you create art of your own? If so, what have you made recently?

I picture everything as a postcard, this helps my creativity. Most recently, I have been making jewelry and mosaics.

5. What was one of your more memorable experiences? One of my most memorable art experiences was at the Morovian Tileworks in Doylestown, PA. I was an artist in residence working in the living museum and having my own studio space.

Another highlight was taking pottery classes in Otsu. My pottery teacher didn't speak English, but we actually communicated quite well non-verbally.

6. Who is your favorite artist?

Paul Gaugin is one of my favorite artists with his use of bold color. I had the opportunity to visit one of his galleries while visiting Tahiti.

7. Current favorite song?

Jimmy Buffets' song, " A Pirate Looks at 40" is one of my favorite songs. Ironically, I first became an honorary "parrothead" after listening to his CD left in my Japan apartment.




